




MONDAY 1 JANUARY

WEDNESDAY 3 JANUARY

ARMITA FROM IRAN

Armita, a young woman from Iran, contacted SAT-7 to say "I thank God that through you, dear friends, we are able to hear God's Word in our own homes. This is the kindness of the Lord that is being shown to us." Pray for Armita and other isolated believers in Iran.

THURSDAY 4 JANUARY THE HOLY LAND

Pray for the ongoing conflict in the Holy Land, that the Lord would soften hard hearts and increase a desire for peace.


FRIDAY 5 JANUARY

ZOHREH FROM IRAN

"Things are very difficult here without a church. I have been a believer for the last 13 years and I am only being fed through your programmes." Pray that Zohreh would find the guidance and Christian fellowship she needs to grow in her faith.

SATURDAY 6 JANUARYCOMFORT MY PEOPLE

"Comfort, comfort my people, says your God" (Isaiah 40:1). Pray for God's comfort as people in the MENA endure ongoing difficulties and seek to rebuild their lives. Pray especially that SAT-7 will be a voice of comfort and strength in the region.



SUNDAY 7 JANUARY

FLOODS IN LIBYA

The September 2023 floods in Libya killed more than 4,300 people, swept away entire towns and left massive destruction in their wake. Pray for God's Spirit to move in the midst of disaster.

MONDAY 8 JANUARY

EARTHQUAKES IN AFGHANISTAN

The earthquakes in 2023 added to the already tumultuous situation in Afghanistan. Pray for people who are mourning loved ones and struggling to rebuild their lives. Pray that the secret Christians who cannot worship freely will be protected and that SAT-7 programmes can offer them hope and comfort.



TUESDAY 9 JANUARY IMPRISONED

"Continue to remember those in prison as if you were together with them in prison, and those who are ill-treated as if you yourselves were suffering" (Hebrews 13:3). Just as the early church prayed for their brothers and sisters who were imprisoned for their faith, let's also remember the persecuted church in the MENA, especially those in prison.

WEDNESDAY 10 JANUARY FAMILIES IN THE HOLY LAND

Pray that the Lord will comfort the families of those who have lost loved ones in the Holy Land conflict. Pray that the Christians in the conflict zones would be able to offer a message of hope and reconciliation.

THURSDAY 11 JANUARY

CHURCH CLOSURES IN ALGERIA

The government of Algeria has closed several churches over the past few years. Pray for strength and boldness among the churches that remain open.

FRIDAY 12 JANUARY

EARTHQUAKE IN MOROCCO

After the September 2023 earthquake in Morocco, Joey, a young Moroccan girl, called into the live SAT-7 KIDS show, Behind the Door. "I was in the same region of the earthquake in Morocco, and all of my family are now in the streets." The presenters prayed for her and she responded, "God, protect us." Pray for Moroccan families that have lost their homes.

SATURDAY 13 JANUARY

REFUGEES

Nasim, a refugee, contacted the SAT-7 PARS team. "As I live in exile and face the hardships and uncertainties of asylum, I sense the Father's embrace. My experience of God is security, peace, comfort and patience." Pray that others facing displacement may find the same comfort Nasim has in God.

SUNDAY 14 JANUARY

ECONOMIC INSECURITY IN IRAN

Armin from Iran told SAT-7, "Please pray for relief from the terrible economic situation in Iran. However much we work we still lack, even though we are not among the poorest. Tonight, I saw your programme for the first time and I was thoroughly blessed. I am comforted by prayer." Pray for Armin and for the economic situation in Iran, and thank God that he hears our prayers.

MONDAY 15 JANUARY

SAT-7 OFFICES

Pray for those working at the SAT-7 offices in the UK, USA, Cyprus, Canada, Brazil and Hong Kong. Praise God for our partnership and pray that we would continue to make God's love visible in the MENA.

TUESDAY 16 JANUARY

KNOWN AND LOVED

Feriyal from Iran said, "I used to think about taking my own life, but since I came to faith I have never again thought about suicide. As I learn more from your teaching, I understand how I am loved by the Lord." Give thanks that Feriyal now knows the love of God.

WEDNESDAY 17 JANUARY

BIBLE HEROES

Shams from Kuwait wrote in to say, "My daughter is nine and she says *Bible Heroes* is her favourite programme." Pray that the show will nurture many young hearts.

THURSDAY 18 JANUARY

SAT-7 PARS STUDIO

Viewers call into the SAT-7 PARS studio as it airs live in London to ask questions about life and faith. Pray that the Holy Spirit will give SAT-7 PARS presenters the words to answer callers' questions.

FRIDAY 19 JANUARY

GOSPEL IN THE GULF

The economic boom in the Gulf states has led to an influx of Christian exparitate workers. Pray that they will shine the light of Christ before their neighbours. Pray that SAT-7's programmes would both encourage Christian migrants and present the gospel to nationals.

SATURDAY 20 JANUARY

ALICAN FROM TURKEY

Alican from Turkey said: "After much research, I accepted Jesus Christ as my Lord and Saviour. The Lord made me a completely different person." Praise God for the change in Alican's life.



SUNDAY 21 JANUARYPARENTS AND CHILDREN

Deuteronomy 6:7 exhorts parents to teach their children about God "...when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up." Pray that Christian parents in the MENA would bring up their children in the knowledge of God, and that SAT-7 KIDS programmes would be a helpful resource for them to draw on.

MONDAY 22 JANUARY

CHILDREN IN SUDAN

As a result of the conflict in Sudan, it is estimated that 13.5 million children are out of school and vulnerable to exploitation, child marriage or recruitment as child-soldiers. Pray that Sudanese parents will be able to protect their children in these terrible circumstances.

TUESDAY 23 JANUARY

BROKEN FAMILIES

At SAT-7, we hear many sad stories of parents and children who are estranged from one another, but also stories of reconciliation. Pray that God will "turn the hearts of the parents to their children, and the hearts of the children to their parents" (Malachi 4:6).

WEDNESDAY 24 JANUARY

INTERNATIONAL DAY OF EDUCATION

Since the Taliban regained control of Afghanistan in 2021, the right of girls to receive an education has been increasingly eroded. Since girls were banned from attending secondary school, many families have been secretly teaching their daughters at home. Pray that Afghan girls will be granted the opportunity to reach their potential.

THURSDAY 25 JANUARY

WITH YOU, LORD, SAFETY ABIDES

Pray for the continued success of the SAT-7 KIDS campaign "With You, Lord, Safety Abides", aimed primarily at 6 to 12-year-olds. Through our children's programmes, SAT-7 KIDS is addressing the traumatic events that many children in the MENA are living through, and giving them the tools they need to process their experiences with God at their side.



FRIDAY 26 JANUARY COMPLETION OF MY SCHOOL

Give thanks for the completion of the final season of SAT-7 KIDS programme My School. Many children have benefitted from the quality educational teaching, especially through times when schools have been closed. Pray that many more children will be benefit as the programme continues to be aired.

SATURDAY 27 JANUARY

PRESSURE TO EXCEL

Janine from Lebanon reached out to the SAT-7 viewer support team, saying, "My children do not like to study, and I am harsh with them because I want them to succeed academically." The team prayed with Janine that God would give her wisdom to encourage her children while showing them they are loved. Pray for parents and children dealing with the immense societal pressure to excel academically.

SUNDAY 28 JANUARY


OF ONE MIND

Safaa from Kuwait responded to a live episode of From Heart to Heart. "If the parents are not in agreement, the children will be lost and confused. Pray for me and my husband, for the Lord to grant us wisdom in raising our children." Pray that Christian parents in the MENA would be of one mind when raising their children.

MONDAY 29 JANUARY

CHILDREN IN THE HOLY LAND

Around half of the population of Gaza are under the age of 18. Pray for the children who are caught in the crossfire of the conflict in the Holy Land.



TUESDAY 30 JANUARY PRAY FOR MUSTAFA

Mustafa, a young man from Algeria, shared that coming from a broken family had led him to overly cling to every friend he makes. He joyfully received the God's love after praying with the SAT-7 counsellor. Pray that children who come from similar situations will be drawn to the God who will never leave them nor forsake them.

WEDNESDAY 31 JANUARY

PARENTS WHO PRAY

Pray for Christian parents who are interceding for their children, especially in countries where culture and social pressure pulls young people in many different directions. Pray that SAT-7's children's programmes on SAT-7 KIDS and other SAT-7 channels will help parents as they raise their children in the faith.



Raped aged 14 and married off to a man 24 years her senior, Hawra' suffered years of abuse. Today, she is an inspirational activist who campaigns against under-age marriage.

Hawra', from Syria, shared her story on SAT-7's new podcast for women in the Middle East. Hosted by SAT-7 presenter Sirene Semerdjian, Ana Podcast features interviews with extraordinary women who have overcome adversity.

Hawra' bravely shared the story of how she was drugged and raped by her own uncle, aged 14. Her family did not believe that it was Hawra''s uncle who had assaulted her. They subsequently arranged

to marry her off to a much older man whom she had never met, a common practice to cover up the shame of a rape in the family.

"I refused and went up to the roof to commit suicide," Hawra' said. After a family member calmed her down, she relented and returned to the living room, where she met the man's daughter from

a previous marriage. "The child kept asking, 'Are you going to be my mother?'" Hawra' said. "I could tell from the way she looked that she was an oppressed little girl. I said, 'Yes, I will be your mother.'"

Despite the awful circumstances, Hawra' enjoyed caring for the four children from her husband's previous marriage, until she was separated from them by her in-laws. She also had two children herself, but her second child, a girl, tragically died aged just 10 months. That was the start of Hawra''s standing up for herself, and for other girls.

"I went to my husband and said, 'I either live with your children or I can't live with you,'" Hawra' said. "I wanted to protect the girls." And so they were reunited.

Hawra' later joined a campaign to lower the percentage of under-age marriages in Lebanon. She began sharing her story with families who were making similar decisions and was successful in preventing a number of under-age marriages.

Asked by Sirene why she joined the campaign, Hawra' said, "Because I didn't want anyone to ever experience my pain... I want youth to know that life is beautiful. Live it the way you want to. Get an education, have freedom, make your own choices, don't let anyone force you into anything."

Hawra' remains married to her husband, and he has become supportive of her campaigning work. "Every time I rescue a young woman from under-age marriage, it gives me a new spirit. It gives me a spirit of strength," she said.
