Children and Youth

MONDAY 1 SEPTEMBER

This week, we will be praying for the children and youth of the MENA, and the SAT-7 programmes that seek to build up their morale and faith. Today, let us pray for young believers who are preparing to go back to school, that they will increasingly shine the light of Christ in that place.

TUESDAY 2 SEPTEMBER

GREAT NEWS

SAT-7 TÜRK's lively news programme for children, *Great News*, continues to air every week day. Pray for the presenter of the programme, Nora Yazırlioğlu, that she will be encouraged in her work for God's Kingdom and Turkish children.

WEDNESDAY 3 SEPTEMBER

JESUS IS OUR STRENGTH

Vibrant SAT-7 KIDS live show *Jesus Is Our Strength* gives young people the chance to discover the love of Jesus and build their lives on the rock of His teaching. Pray for the many young viewers who are contacting the presenters through messages and phone-ins, that they will truly come to know Jesus as their strength.

THURSDAY 4 SEPTEMBER

SHARING

"Thank you so much for this wonderful programme," said Hanaa, a teenage girl who has been watching *Jesus is Our Strength*. "I wanted to say that I love you all so much... SATURDAY 6 SEPTEMBER

CHALLENGE ACCEPTED

SAT-7 KIDS gameshow *Challenge Accepted*, now in its fourth series, helps children work together, overcome obstacles, grow as people, and apply biblical teachings to their everyday lives. Ask God to bless each and every contestant, giving them new perspective and courage to tackle the challenges in their lives.

SUNDAY 7 SEPTEMBER

"OBEY YOUR PARENTS"

"Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right" (Ephesians 6:1). Pray that God will help children from Christian families in the MENA heed this command, and that He will help Christian parents create a nurturing and godly environment for their children.

MONDAY 8 SEPTEMBER

INTERNATIONAL LITERACY DAY

In Afghanistan, many children – especially girls – struggle to attain a high-quality education. SAT-7 PARS is aiming to meet that need through new programme *Sun of Hope*, which offers free primary education in the Afghan Persian language. This International Literacy Day, pray that *Sun of Hope* viewers will grow in their reading and writing skills, and that this will open up opportunities for them in the future.

TUESDAY 9 SEPTEMBER

POWER OF PRAYER

Presented by Ayda Danacıoğlu, *Power of Prayer* explores and prays for a different theme in each of its episodes. Both Christians and non-Christians send in their concerns and prayer requests while Ayda lifts their situations up to the Lord. Pray that more Turkish people will see God do miracles in response to their prayers!

WEDNESDAY 10 SEPTEMBER

"I CAN'T THANK YOU ENOUGH"

"I can't thank you enough," said Mounira, a teenage girl from Morocco who reached out to our Viewer Support team. "Thank you for your prayers, your encouragement, and your support. May God ease your troubles and bring you happiness, just as you bring joy to me with your words." Thank God for Mounira's experience and pray that our Arabic Viewer Support team will be filled with the Holy Spirit as they seek to bless many more young people.

THURSDAY 11 SEPTEMBER

QUALITY TIME

Through songs, Bible readings, and discussions, *Quality Time* is helping the youth of the Arabic world explore various topics from a Christian perspective and build their lives on a biblical foundation. Pray that many young people will be strengthened in their faith as a result of this programme.

FRIDAY 12 SEPTEMBER

Whether impacted by war, economic strife, or discrimination, Christian workers in the MENA can struggle to find and retain satisfying jobs. Let us start by praying for SAT-7 viewers who have lost their jobs in recent months, that God will meet their needs and lead them towards new opportunities.

SATURDAY 13 SEPTEMBER

NOULIFAR FROM IRAN

"We prayed for my husband to find a job and we received a call from an employer asking him to start in a new [one]," Noulifar from Iran told us recently. "Thank God – the Father's will is being done and He is not allowing us to suffer from poverty, and He is opening a new chapter in our lives. Thanks and praise be to His name. Thank you for being there for us." Give thanks to God for answering Noulifar's prayers.

SUNDAY 14 SEPTEMBER

SATISFACTION FROM TOIL

"I know that there is nothing better for people than to be happy and to do good while they live. That each of them may eat and drink, and find satisfaction in all their toil—this is the gift of God" (Ecclesiastes 3:12-13). Thank God for the gift of work, and pray that our viewers in the MENA will learn to see it as such.

MONDAY 15 SEPTEMBER

JOBSEEKERS

"I have been searching for a job that aligns with my Lord's wishes for a long time," said Nüket, a woman from Türkiye. "I want to serve and work for Him. Would you please pray for me?" Pray that Nüket, and other jobseekers in Türkiye, will grow in patience and trust God's guidance as they look for work.

TUESDAY 16 SEPTEMBER

WORK AND FINANCES

SAT-7 PARS programme *Mirror* equips Persian-speaking believers to approach their life and work with courage, wisdom and skill. Presenters share

practical lessons, lifestyle advice, stress management techniques, and financial tips, all approached from a Christian perspective. Pray that viewers will be inspired to practice godly wisdom in their work and finances.

WEDNESDAY 17 SEPTEMBER

SOREN FROM IRAN

"I have become unemployed due to the unjust closure of my workplace by the government," explained Soren, a male SAT-7 PARS viewer from Iran. "I have always worked in the way that Christ instructed, not for earthly masters but as if I am working for Him, and I have genuinely served people through my work... Please pray in the name of the Lord Jesus that this issue is resolved... I want to work wherever His will leads me." Thank God for Soren's maturity and pray that God's will is done in his work life.

THURSDAY 18 SEPTEMBER

BUSINESS OWNERS

Bengü, a viewer of SAT-7 TÜRK programme *Homemade*, said: "Thank you for supporting the empowerment of

women and for backing small businesses and entrepreneurs. I'm very pleased to find you." Pray for Christian business owners and entrepreneurs in Türkiye, that they will shine the light of Christ in their workplaces and communities.

SATURDAY 27 SEPTEMBER

FRUIT

"Before I believed in Jesus Christ, my soul was cold and my life was like that of a walking dead person," said Arya from Iran. "Since I came to believe in the Lord, my soul has come alive... I have become kinder and more forgiving. These are the

fruits that have appeared within me and have brought my soul to life." Thank God for Arya's transformation and pray that he will continue producing fruit.

SUNDAY 28 SEPTEMBER

"THE WORKERS ARE FEW"

"Then he said to his disciples, 'The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field'" (Matthew 9:37-38). Let us respond to Jesus' call to prayer by asking that God will raise up more workers who will contribute to SAT-7's work in the MENA.

MONDAY 29 SEPTEMBER

FOOD FROM HOME
