- Follow the SAT-7 UK security guidelines whenever you speak or write on behalf of SAT-7 UK
- Inform the SAT-7 UK office of all activities being undertaken on behalf of SAT-7 UK and accept the oversight of SAT-7 UK staff
- Respect the requests of the group to which you are speaking, including good timekeeping in relation to arrival and the duration of any talk
- Pass on all monies you receive on behalf of SAT-7 UK directly to SAT-7 UK
- Ensure all equipment used is maintained and is safe and fit for purpose.
- Observe health and safety precautions when carrying and setting up equipment and publicity materials to avoid injury to yourselves or to others
- Treat as confidential any personal information you hear or see about SAT-7 UK supporters and do not pass on to any person outside SAT-7 UK
