SATURDAY 1 NOVEMBER CONNECTION

Persecution, social unrest and even the rapid digitalisation of society are contributing to Christians feeling disconnected from God and one another. Pray that Christians in the MENA will not forget the importance of prayer and face-to-face gatherings.

SUNDAY 2 NOVEMBER

THE PERSECUTED CHURCH

"'For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them'" (Matthew 18:20). As the International Day Of Prayer For The Persecuted Church is marked, pray for those who are living secret lives of faith, that they will be able to connect with other Christians in safety – even in twos and threes.

MONDAY 3 NOVEMBER

CONVERSATIONS

Last year, our Viewer Support team had 87,000 conversations with people in the MENA. Thank God that these people connected with SAT-7, and pray that their faith will deepen as a result of speaking to us.

TUESDAY 4 NOVEMBER

INTERNET PROBLEMS

The Iranian government routinely restricts or blocks internet access, making it difficult for our viewers to engage with our programmes consistently. Pray that Christians will not be deterred in their attempts to connect with SAT-7 and other Christian individuals and organisations.

WEDNESDAY 5 NOVEMBER

WASSIM FROM EGYPT

After watching a sermon on SAT-7 ARABIC's YouTube page, Wassim from Egypt commented: "You truly opened my mind to a proper understanding of real prayer. This understanding allows me the chance for a better connection with my Creator." Pray for Wassim's prayer life to blossom.

THURSDAY 6 NOVEMBER

ONLINE GATHERINGS

We have several online gatherings for Persian-speaking Christians, such as Church4Kids, Church4Afghanistan (pictured), and the Zoom teaching sessions. Pray that more isolated believers will find these groups and feel connected to the Body of Christ in the MENA.



FRIDAY 7 NOVEMBER

TURKISH CHURCH

"We must be connected to each other, and we should be united in our relationships," said Musa after watching an episode of SAT-7 TÜRK programme Homemade. "We should love one another and stand firm in true faith in Jesus Christ." Pray that the Turkish church will grow in unity as they focus on Christ.

SATURDAY 8 NOVEMBER

"INTENSE PERSECUTION"

"My wife and I, along with our four children, follow the Holy Bible with deep sincerity and commitment, despite intense persecution," said Rayan, a SAT-7 ARABIC viewer from Syria who is currently living in Lebanon. Pray for Rayan, and other Syrian Christians like him, that they will be filled with faith, wisdom and courage.

SUNDAY 9 NOVEMBER "MEET ALL YOUR NEEDS"

"And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus" (Philippians 4:19). With thankful hearts for all God's provision thus far, let us pray for SAT-7's finances, asking that He will continue to meet the needs of our ministry over the coming months.



MONDAY 10 NOVEMBER

CYPRUS

SAT-7's International Office is based in Nicosia, a city of around half a million people in the southern, Greek half of Cyprus. Pray for the security of SAT-7's staff who live on the island and for God's favour on the charity's headquarters.

TUESDAY 11 NOVEMBER AYAT FROM ALGERIA

"I want to have a real relationship with God," said Ayat, a woman in her 20s from Algeria. "How do you surrender your spirit, heart, life, and thoughts to God?" Pray for God to bless Ayat through the Viewer Support team members who are answering her heartfelt questions.

THURSDAY 20 NOVEMBER

Erfan from Afghanistan contacted us to say: "I have just come to faith in Christ... but I don't know much about the faith. I have no family, no home, and no life. Every night I sleep in a different place and often go to bed hungry. I search for work every day but have not succeeded yet." Pray that the Lord will sustain Erfan both spiritually and physically.

SUNDAY 23 NOVEMBER

WISDOM

"If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you" (James 1:5). Pray that SAT-7 staff will grow in their desire for wisdom so they can make good choices that lead to positive change.

MONDAY 24 NOVEMBER HEALING

Many of our interactions with viewers centre on brokenness and healing – whether that be physical, emotional, or otherwise. Pray that our Viewer Support team will be increasingly equipped to deal with the wide variety of people and circumstances they encounter.



TUESDAY 25 NOVEMBER EMOTIONAL HEALING

Sarah from Egypt felt rejected and humiliated from a young age. After sharing her scars with us, we prayed for her and guided her to a new understanding of God's love. "God's mercy towards us is immense, and we are always surrounded by it," she said. Pray that Sarah will continue to build her life on God's love.

WEDNESDAY 26 NOVEMBERPATHWAY TO HEALING

Pathway to Healing is a new Christian counselling programme tailored to addressing mental health, family challenges, and social issues prevalent in Persianspeaking communities. Pray that many viewers will experience healing through this programme.

THURSDAY 27 NOVEMBER

"GOD INTERVENED"

Hailey from the United Arab Emirates asked us to pray for her daughter who needed a brain scan. Eventually we got this update: "God intervened and worked a miracle on her behalf. My daughter is well now and is able to go to school." Thank God for intervening and pray for the family's faith to be strengthened.

FRIDAY 28 NOVEMBER

HEALED FROM ADDICTION

"My son was long addicted to drugs and I prayed for years," said Lale, an Iranian SAT-7 PARS viewer. "He has now quit. The Lord has answered my prayers, and yours, and He has healed my son... I thank God for you and for His miracle in my son." Thank God for this wonderful news and pray that Lale's son will stay clean.

HEALING YET TO HAPPEN
