SUNDAY 1 FEBRUARY

"All your children will be taught by the Lord, and great will be their peace" (Isaiah 54:13). This week, we will be focussing on our young viewers in the Persian-speaking world. Let us start by praying for SAT-7 staff members who create programmes for, and interact with, these young ones. May they teach the things of the Lord and share His peace.

MONDAY 2 FEBRUARY

GOLPAND

WEDNESDAY 4 FEBRUARY

FUTURE OF IRAN

There is a great desire for change in Iranian society, but the government only doubled down its approach in the aftermath of the 'Woman. Life. Freedom' protests of 2022 and 2023. Pray that God will raise up young changemakers to impact society for good.

THURSDAY 5 FEBRUARY

"WITHIN OUR HEARTS"

"As Christians, we believe that changing the world starts from within our hearts," said Armita, an Afghan teenage girl living in Tajikistan who regularly contacts our presenters. "The world becomes a better place when people's hearts are changed and this can only happen through the love and grace of Jesus Christ." Thank God for what Armita shared, and pray for God's blessing on her and her family.

FRIDAY 6 FEBRUARY

SUN OF HOPE

Dari-language programme *Sun of Hope* is bringing free primary-level education to young Afghans. Pray that the programme's viewers will make real progress academically and put their new knowledge to good use.

SATURDAY 7 FEBRUARY

VIEWER CONNECTION

"[SAT-7 presenter] Meersedeh suggested that I get a gratitude journal," said young Nava. "Since then, I've witnessed a deepening of my relationship with God and many significant changes in my life.

SUNDAY 8 FEBRUARY

“ALL THOSE IN AUTHORITY”

MONDAY 9 FEBRUARY

TUESDAY 10 FEBRUARY

Many of SAT-7’s staff and programme guests use their creative and artistic talents – such as musicianship, camera work, design, scripting and more – to bless people in the MENA. Pray they will develop a biblical understanding of creativity and continue to sharpen their skills.

WEDNESDAY 11 FEBRUARY

ONLINE BULLYING

Social media can be a desperately difficult thing for young people to navigate. Pray for Christian children in the MENA who have been subject to bullying online, that they will find healing and support from God and their loved ones.

Local churches

THURSDAY 12 FEBRUARY

If it is safe for our viewers to engage with their local churches, SAT-7 encourages that. If it is not, SAT-7 helps people connect to the Body of Christ through

live broadcasts of church services and online fellowship groups. Pray for greater collaboration between SAT-7 and local churches in the MENA.

FRIDAY 13 FEBRUARY

KDEC FRIDAY SERVICE

SAT-7 ARABIC broadcasts the Friday service at Kasr El-Dobara Evangelical Church in Egypt (pictured above), helping Arab Christians access high-quality teaching and beautiful worship music every week. Pray for the church congregation to experience God’s guidance and provision this year.

SATURDAY 14 FEBRUARY

FIROZEH FROM IRAN

“I have been watching *Church4Kids* for about four years and I am keen to know more about God and to learn more about the Bible,” said Firozeh, a girl from Iran. “I would really like to be in a church in person and to see what it is like. Last year I went to a local Armenian church and I was glad to be allowed in.” Pray that Firozeh will find a way to connect with Christians in person more regularly.

SUNDAY 15 FEBRUARY

"GRATITUDE IN YOUR HEARTS"

MONDAY 16 FEBRUARY

WELL CONNECTED

"[Fifteen years ago] I became acquainted with the Gospel through a friend whose brother was a pastor in Türkiye," said Parastoo, an Iranian woman. "In recent years, after becoming familiar with Christian television networks, my faith was revived. I connect online on Sundays and participate in live programmes, and now I attend prayer meetings and teachings." Pray that Parastoo will help other Iranians participate in Christian gatherings.

TUESDAY 17 FEBRUARY

RESURRECTION BAPTIST CHURCH

SAT-7 broadcasts church services live from Resurrection Baptist Church in Lebanon, helping Christians in the region connect with the wider Body of Christ even if they are restricted from it in their local area. Pray that viewers will be inspired in their faith as they engage with the services.

WEDNESDAY 18 FEBRUARY

LENT BEGINS

Christians in the UK celebrate the start of Lent today, and most MENA churches begin Lent next week. Pray for Christians in the UK and around the world who are seeking God in special ways during this time. May they hear His voice and encounter His love as they gather and reflect.

YEMEN

SAT-7 TÜRK's staff team, based at our Istanbul studio, has had to show resilience in abundance in recent years, with their country experiencing several traumatic events including a catastrophic earthquake, attacks on churches, an

epidemic of violence against women, and waves of riots. Throughout it all, the team has kept their channel up and running and supported Turkish Christians. Pray that they will know God's comfort and encouragement as they push ahead.

FRIDAY 27 FEBRUARY

NARROW DOOR

SAT-7 TÜRK programme *Narrow Door*, which returned for its second series in the autumn of 2025, is a news show with a twist. Pray for wisdom for its presenters as they discuss the spiritual lessons and human stories behind current events.

SATURDAY 28 FEBRUARY
