 You hear **a reading from the Bible**.

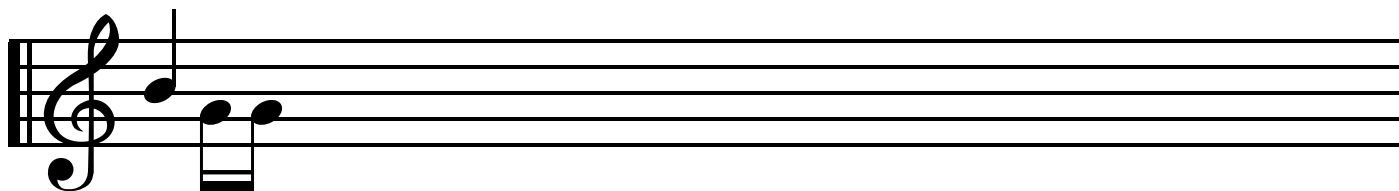
2. As you watch the live event on your screen, colour in a square when (and if) you see or hear these things. The winner is:

- The first person to colour in all of the boxes OR the person with the most boxes coloured in at the end of your event.

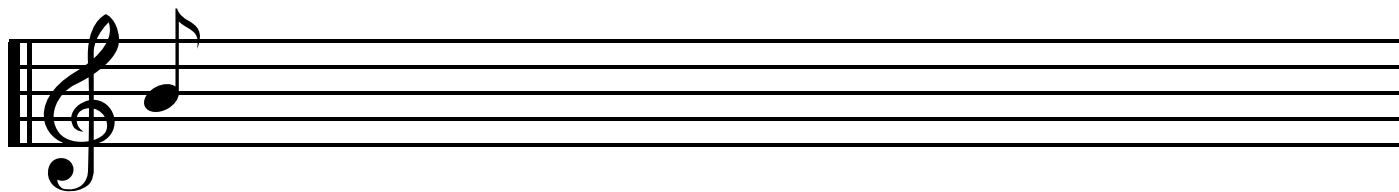
MUSICAL MOOD MAP!

As you watch Prom Praise, note down the things which strike you most. During or after the livestream, you can use this template to reflect individually or share with a group.

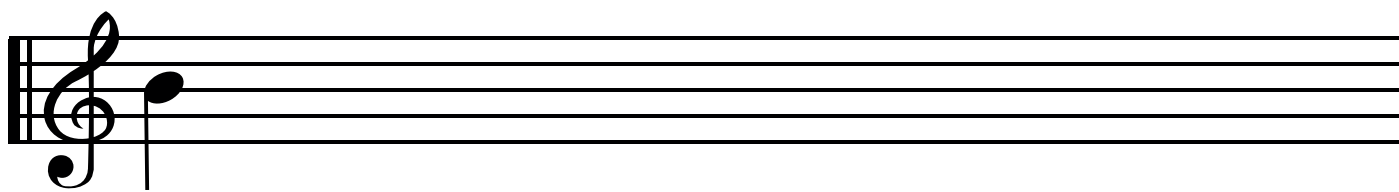
The music, song, or words which **moved me** most:



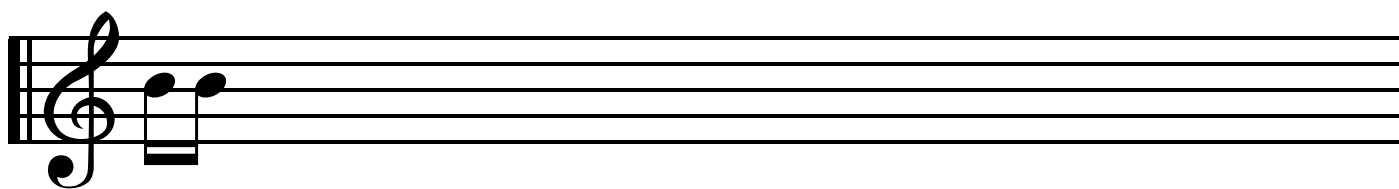
The music, song, or words which **surprised me** most:



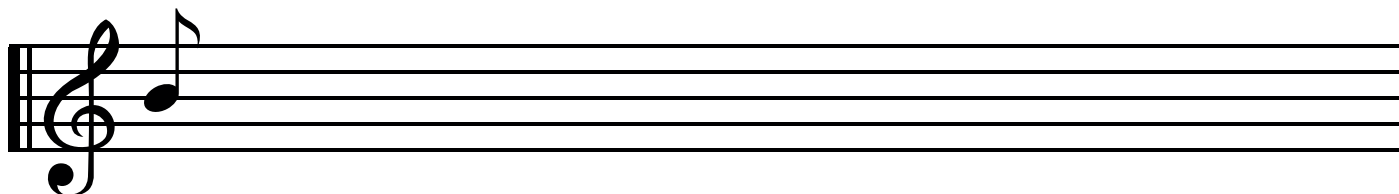
The music, song, or words that brought back **a special memory**:



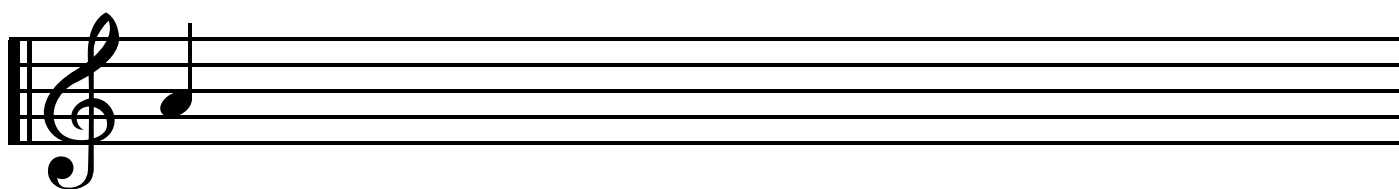
