TUESDAY 1 SEPTEMBER

TUESDAY 29 SEPTEMBER FINANCIAL PROVISION

The war in Iran has left many in great need. Arzhang told us: "The situation was very difficult for us, and we experienced the kind of financial hard-ship that we had never experienced before. However, I saw more of God's love and His wonderful works. I don't take that for granted." Pray for physical and spiritual provision for people in Iran.

WEDNESDAY 30 SEPTEMBER "FEEDING MY SPIRIT"

"Since I have been connected with you and listening to God's living word at night, I have become accustomed to feeding my spirit with spiritual food before going to sleep," said Touraj, a male SAT-7 PARS viewer.
